School Board Policies

POLICY 5540 ABUSE/NEGLECT

Any employee of the School District having reasonable as suspect that a student seen in the course of professional duties has been subject to physical, sexual notional abuse or has been neglected, shall immediately report such suspected abuse or neglected by Wisconsin Statutes. Such personnel shall also report having reason to believe that a student in the course of professional duties has been threatened with an injury and at habuse of student will occur.

RULE 5540 ABUSE/NEGLECT

The report of suspected abuse or neglect shall be too abuse. Kenosha County Departent of Social Services immediately. If contact cannot be made with attagency the appropriate law enforcement agency be notified.

Neglect or abuse refers to harm to a student'sipaly psychological or intellectual functioning which is exhibited by severe anxiety, depression, withdrawal or outward aggressive behavior, actual physical evidence or a combination of the above symptoms caused bytthem t's parent/guardian, legal custodian or other person. Persons reporting suspected student abuseglect shall be immune from any legal action from such reporting. The identity of the person making such a report shall be kept confidential in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes. Failure to report student abuseglect may result in a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00.

School personnel shall not contact the family or options to seek an explanation or to determine the causes of any suspected abuse or neglect.

Investigation of suspected student abuse or neglect shall be done by the Department of Social Services or by police investigators. The agency making such investig may contact, observe, or interview a student on school premises without permission from the student's parent, guardian, or legal custodian if necessary to determine if the student is in need of protections envices. Interviewing of a student involved in such a complaint by representatives of the Department of Services may be done without the presence of the principal/designee.

The Superintendent of Schools shall distribute a continuity policy to all school personnel, annually.
