The Kenosha School District acknowledges its responsibility to permit individuals with disabilities to be accompanied by a service animal in its facilities as required by the Americans with Disabilities

A service animal is may dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. Other species of animals whether wild or domestic, trained or untrained, are not service animals for the purposes of this definition.
