## POLICY 5260 FULL TIME OPEN ENROLLMENT

## Nonresident Students Attending School in the District

A nonresident student residing within the State of Wisconsin may apply fetimfellenrollment in a Kenosha Unified School District school under the public school open enrollment program in accordance with state law and established procedures. Therefore the following criteria when accepting or rejecting a nonresident studentapplication for fulltime enrollment:

- 1. The district shall consider the availability of space in the schools and classrooms with strictle d studentteacher ratios including educational assistant ratios, and enrollment projections. Space availability decisions shall be made in accordance with district policies and procedures.
- 2. The district shall not enroll a student if that student was habitually truant during any semester of attendanc@from the enrolledschool district in the current or previous school year.
- 3. The district shall not enroll a student during the term of the student's expulsc(t)-4 htse te 3p24(t.9(y s)--17

Once accepted for enrollment, the strict shall assign the nonresident student to a school or program in accordance with district policies and procedures. The strict shall give preference in attender as school, program, class or grade to resident students who live outside the school's attendance area.

Nonresident open enrollment studewill not be required to reapply more than once, except:

- xAll nonresident open enrollment students attending ettaryschool in the District shall be required to reapply for enrollment prior to admission to middle school.
- xAll nonresident open enrollment students who come into the district on open enrollment at the middle school level will need to reapply for openrollment at the high school level

Student transportation shall be the responsibility of the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) or the adult student except as otherwise required by law.

Nonresident open enrollment students attending a school or program in the house eight the rights and privileges of resident students and are subject to the same rules and regulations as resident students.

Nonresident open enrollment students may have their enrollment terminated due to habitual truancy. The definitions and notifications for open enrolled habitual truant students will be consistent with those of residentstudents (KUSD Policy 5310). The resident school district of open enrolled students will also receive these notifications.

Nonresident students that attend a school that does not offer WIAA athletics will be assigned, on a lottery basis, a WIAAeligible school for sports, extraurricular activities and fine arts.

Any student residing in the Kenosha Unified School District hasalready provided the required resident verification material hall be allowed to attend public school in another district on atifued basis if the student has filed the appropriate application with that school district and has been accepted for enrollment

The student's parent(s)/guardian(sur the adult student shall be responsible for providing student transportation to antdom the nonresident district.

A resident student attending school outside the district under open enrollment may be allowed to enroll in Part Time Open Enrollment four to two high school courses at a time in the resident district as outlined in the Part Time Open Enrollment Poli5270. However, a resident student attending school outside the district under open enrollment may not be allowed to participate in exticate a activities in the resident district.
