The Start College NowProgramis a postsecondary participation program sponsored by the Wisconsin Technical Colleges. This program is availablegto school students in grades eleven and twelvewho meet the program requirements and may be able to earth brooth school and technical college redit. Students wishing to participate in the Start College Now Programy not be concurrently enrolled in the Wisconsin Early College Credit Programine courses offered eligible technical college providers should be treated in the same manner as coursest offered technical college campus. The Start College NowProgram opens the door to greater learning opportunities for students wishing to begin college early understts who want to prepare to enter the workforce immediately after high school graduation. Students enrolled in grades ten and even in the dstrict shall be informed of the Start College NowProgram annually, prior to October 1 of the preceding school year.

Decisions regarding comparability courses, satisfaction district graduation requirements and the awarding of high school credit courses akenthrough the Start College Notwogram are made in accordance with state law and established to procedures.

Through the Start College Now Program students may receive both high school and technical collegecredit for successfully completed cours District highschools grant a diploma to students who successfully complete strict high school graduation equirements regardless of whether the student satisfied all or any portion of the requirements through the Start College Now ogram.
